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Kick-off Meeting in Trondheim, Norway

On September 18th, the POMEIL consortium convened in Trondheim, Norway, for the project's official kick-off, hosted by KBT Fagskole AS. The consortium comprises six organizations representing Estonia, Greece, Poland, and Norway, all collaborating on the POMEIL initiative.

Project Aim

The POMEIL projects target the upskilling and reskilling of immigrants and refugees, with a special focus on Ukrainian refugees, regarding their entrepreneurship and cross-cultural skills.

The project will develop digital escape rooms presenting real-life scenarios that will act as an assessment and offer personalized learning pathways, fostering the entrepreneurial and cross-cultural skill gaps of immigrants and refugees.
